








**PQI 06: Pediatric Gastroenteritis [severe vomiting and/or severe diarrhea in children]






**PQI 08: Congestive Heart Failure (CHF) [*heart failure*]






**PQI 11: Bacterial Pneumonia


**PQI 12: Urinary Tract Infection (UTI)
