(Maximum Risk Allowed By State Law is \$3 Billion)




Exhibit 2 Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development **Cal-Mortgage Loan Insurance Division**

Number of Insured Loans



Percentage of Insured Loan Balance by Facility Type as of June 30, 2017



Number of Insured Loans by Facility Type as of June 30, 2017



Annual Interest Earned on the Health Facility Construction Loan Insurance Fund



