

**San Mateo County  
Mental Health Loan Assumption Program  
2013**

San Mateo County applicants must meet the following hard to fill/retain criteria, based on priority workforce needs, to be considered eligible for the MHLAP.\*

Must Have:

**Work/Volunteer Hours**  
Work a minimum of 20 hours per week in a public mental health program.

**Employment Status**  
Must be employed in a permanent position for a minimum of one year.

**Total Weekly Hours of Direct Clinical Service**  
Must provide a minimum of 20 hours direct service.

**Work Location**  
Work within an eligible BHRS county-operated or contracted behavioral health care agency, or at San Mateo Medical Center in psychological services. \*\*

At least one of the following

<b>Providers who are bi-lingual in one of the County's threshold languages and/or who represent the ethnically and culturally diverse communities that BHRS serves.</b>	Speak Spanish, Chinese (Cantonese, Mandarin), Russian, Tagalog, Tongan
	AND/OR
	Represent the ethnically and culturally diverse communities that BHRS serves
<b>OR</b>	
<b>Providers in hard to fill/retain positions or those who possess experience/expertise in hard to fill/retain skill sets.</b>	Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioners/Advanced Practice Nurses Child Psychiatrists
