



# UC Irvine/ UC Davis Train New Trainers (TNT) Primary Care Psychiatry (PCP) Fellowship

## **RECRUITING NOW FOR JANUARY 2021**

The TNT PCP Fellowship is a year-long clinical education program for primary care-oriented trainees and providers who wish to receive advanced training in primary care psychiatry.

### **Who Benefits?**

---

The program is designed for primary care providers working in Internal medicine, Family medicine, Emergency medicine, Pediatrics, or Neurology. Past fellows have included MD, DOs, PAs, NPs, and clinical pharmacists.

### **Curriculum**

---

The curriculum includes over 50 hours of training and will lead to a certificate of completion from the UC Irvine Department of Psychiatry and Human Behavior:

- Two weekend teaching sessions (24-28 CME hours)
- One hour per month of mentoring sessions with a TNT fellowship faculty member/mentor (12 hours)
- Twice-per-month, live case-based discussions and patient interview with a focus on integrated primary care psychiatry--held on Mondays at either 12:00 or 5:15 p.m. (PST) via teleconference (20 CME hours)

### **Goals of TNT PCP Fellowship**

---

Trainees will learn:

- How to complete an evidence-based & efficient psychiatric interview in the busy primary care/medical setting
- How to effectively diagnose and treat commonly encountered psychiatric conditions such as mood, anxiety, psychotic, and substance misuse disorders
- How to teach these principles to their primary care colleagues

*This is not a traditional or Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) approved fellowship*

### **2020 Tuition**

---

- \$15,500 per fellow OR applicants may be eligible for a full scholarship: upon acceptance to the TNT Program, a scholarship application will be sent with instructions for completion and submission for consideration by the California Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD).

### **OSHPD Scholarship**

---

**Deadline to apply for scholarship is August 24, 2020 at 11:45 p.m. PST**

***Your application must be submitted online to the TNT program by August 17, 2020 for review. Upon approval, you will receive the link for the OSHPD scholarship application.***

***Deadlines are subject to change as funding is limited.***

You must meet the minimum requirements to be considered:

- Be currently employed or have accepted employment as a primary care or emergency provider (MD, DO, NP, PA) in the following specialties: family medicine, internal medicine, OB/GYN, or pediatrics
- Work at a qualifying practice site in a Federally Qualified Health Center/lookalike, Health Professional Shortage Area–Primary Care (HPSA-PC) or Primary Care Shortage Area (PCSA) in California
- Work at a practice site with at least 50 percent of patients from a medically underserved population (Medi-Cal, uninsured, or beneficiaries of another publicly funded program that serves patients who earn less than 250 percent of the federal poverty level)
