- An IOR who fails to perform adequately and competently can seriously jeopardize the chance for a successful project.

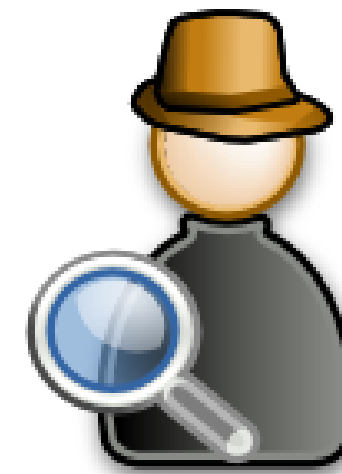

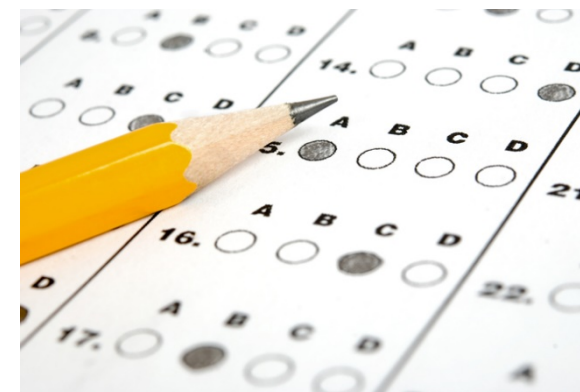
