June 30, 1990 through June 30, 2021 (Maximum Risk Allowed By State Law is \$3 Billion)



June 30, 1990 through June 30, 2021





Percentage of Insured Loan Balance by Facility Type as of June 30, 2021

Number of Insured Loans by Facility Type as of June 30, 2021



June 30, 2007 through June 30, 2021




